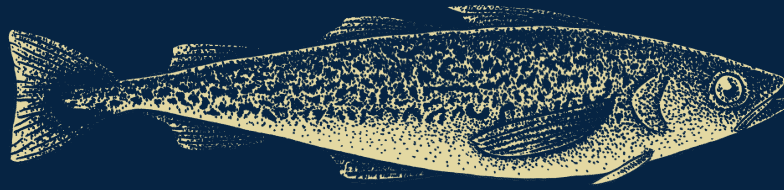

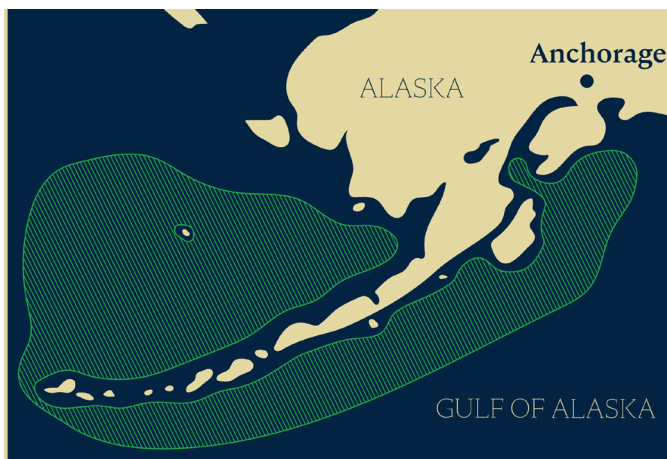

The cold, nutrient-rich waters of the Bering Sea and North Pacific Ocean are home to our Alaska pollock. Feeding on shrimp, squid and small fish, this highly abundant fish supports the world's largest certified sustainable fishery! Pollock is caught using large nets that are towed behind the vessel at a specific depth where the fish are swimming. Some of these large trawler vessels also function as at-sea factories where fresh fish is gutted and frozen within hours of catch, preserving the freshness and quality of the product. After being shipped by frozen container to Vietnam, the fish are hand filleted in a professional quality facility where each fillet is checked to conform to our standards.
